SUNDAY MORNINGS

Worship Hour

- Children take part in the first portion of our worship service, and then they can go out to Church School if they wish. There is a nursery for babies & toddlers, and classrooms for all school-aged kids.
- Children are always welcome to stay for the entire worship service if they prefer.

THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

House Committees

- Our church family is divided into 11 houses, one for each month of the year, with a combined house for July & August. House members are asked to help out with events during their month. The main commitment is serving coffee after church that month. There is also a Men's Club Supper each month that the house caters.
- If you can help out once a year, please contact the church office and you will be assigned to a house.

Choirs

- The Senior Choir sings every Sunday morning at our Worship Service. They practice on Thursdays from 7:45-9:15 p.m.
- The Handbell Choir performs a few times per year. They practice on Thursdays from 6:15-7:30 p.m.

Study Groups

- Sunday Morning – This group meets at 9:00 a.m. in the kitchen lounge to discuss books, articles, and ideas.
- Friday Noon – This group meets every second Friday for lunch and to watch videos, discuss books, and grow in faith.

Susanna Wesley Group

- This women's group meets on the 4th Tuesday of each month in the afternoon.

Men's Club

- The Men's Club meets on the first Friday of every month. They have a supper meeting, and a different program each month.
- The Men's Club serves the church in a variety of ways, such as providing Bibles for the Grade 3 students, the Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper, and the Garage & Book Sale.

Youth Group

- Teens get together every Sunday morning during the worship service, and they also usually do an activity once a month.
- A tri-church youth group including younger kids from Wesley, Whitmore Park, and Sunset United Churches is also starting up.

Knitting & Fellowship

- The knitters and crocheters meet on Monday at 10:00 a.m. This is a time for visiting, working on your own projects, or working on projects for the church's Christmas Market or Prayer Shawl Ministry.

Potluck & Play Group

- Young families gather together for a potluck meal once a month. If you would like to be on the email list for this group to find out their upcoming dates, please contact the church office or watch the announcements for details.

Book Club

- This drop-in book club is open to anyone who would like to do some casual reading and meet for a discussion. We borrow the books from the library so there are copies available if you need one.

Reading Buddies

- These volunteers spend one morning per week with elementary students at a particular school, helping them read and giving them personalized attention. This program lasts for 5 weeks in the fall and spring.
